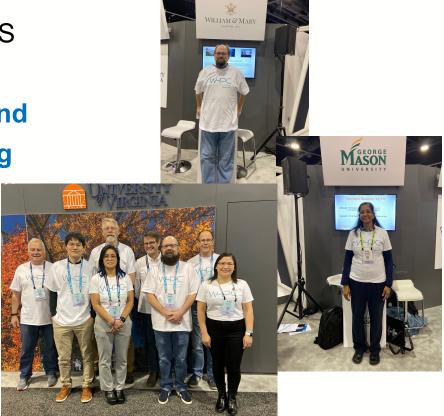


### Virginia Women in HPC

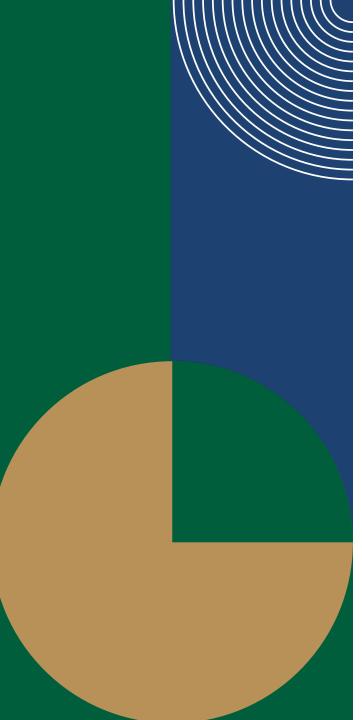

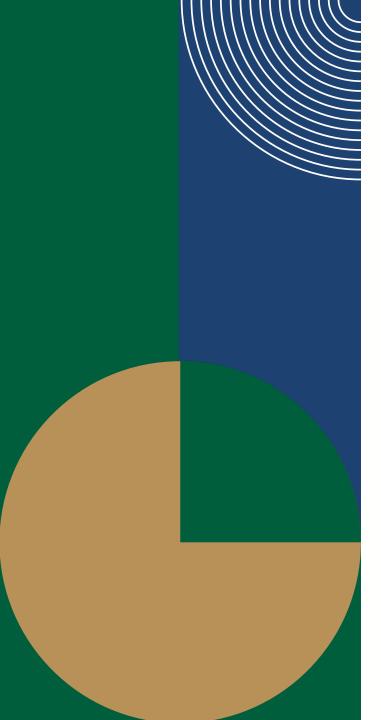
